> Mary Peabody and Bertha Saltmarsh bought the lot from Joshua Jenks in 1884. They had a shingle style cottage built that may have been designed by Antoine Dorticos. Everett Peabody acquired the property in the early 1900s and sold it to the Boy Scouts in 1934. The house burned in a Deer Point fire in the 1940s. The Boy Scouts sold the property in 1979, and it was sold to a Freeport couple in July 2023. Submitted by Donna Damon
