Ellsworth Miller Lecture Series

On April 12th Donna Miller Damon presented "The Roots of Chebeague's Tourism, and its Impact on the Chebeague Community." Donna's illustrated talk focused on Chebeague's evolution from an independent middle class community to a place dependent on tourism, and the role that print media played in the creation of myths and the perpetuation of stereotypes during the late 19th and early 20th centuries. On May 10th Kate Kennedy—an author with island roots—will discuss her book featuring Maine's remarkable women. Ms. Kennedy will introduce the audience to strong and determined women who broke through social, cultural, and political barriers.
