Clausnitzer Jr., Ph.D.** is a historical archaeologist specializing in early modern New England, particularly the role of cod fisheries in the settlement of New England and the development of a distinctly New England lifestyle. Besides working in every New England state north of, and including, Massachusetts, Art has participated in digs in Newfoundland, Canada, and Ireland, with some of the more noticeable sites being the Rebecca Nurse Homestead in Danvers, Massachusetts, the Isles of Shoals in Portsmouth, NH, and Kittery, ME, and the Colony of Avalon in Ferryland, Newfoundland, Canada. Art currently works as a **historical archaeologist and serves as a principal investigator for the Northeast Archaeology Research Center, Inc., based in Farmington.**
